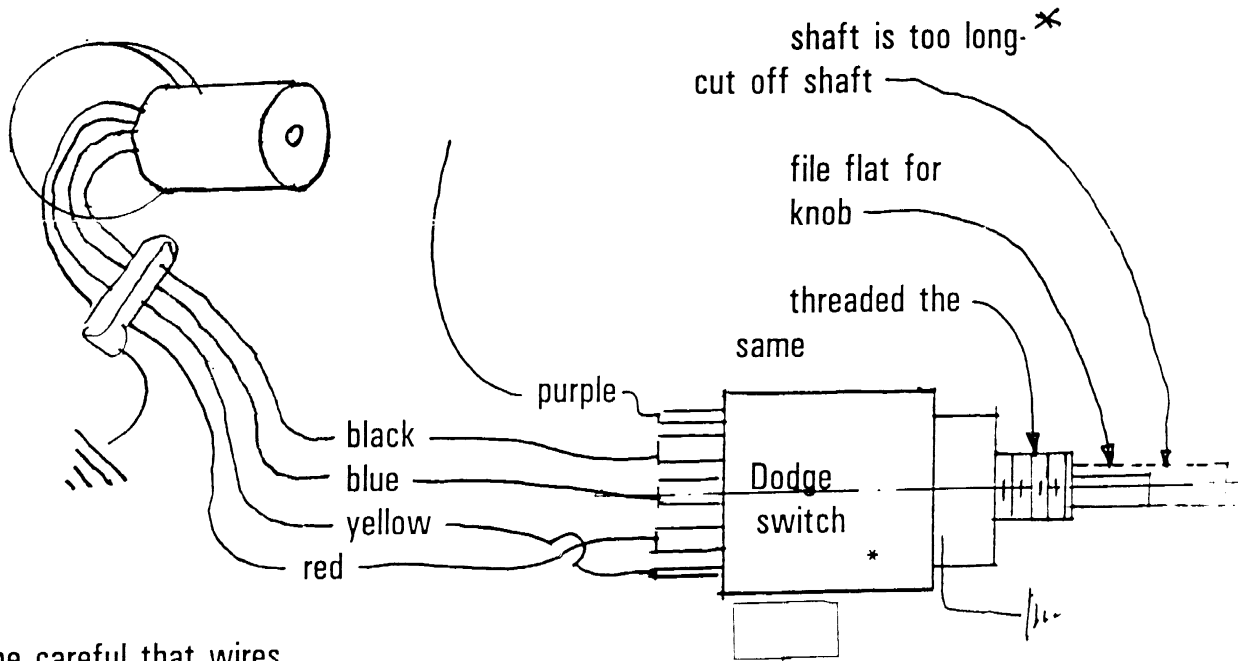


Avanti Wiper Switch Substitution

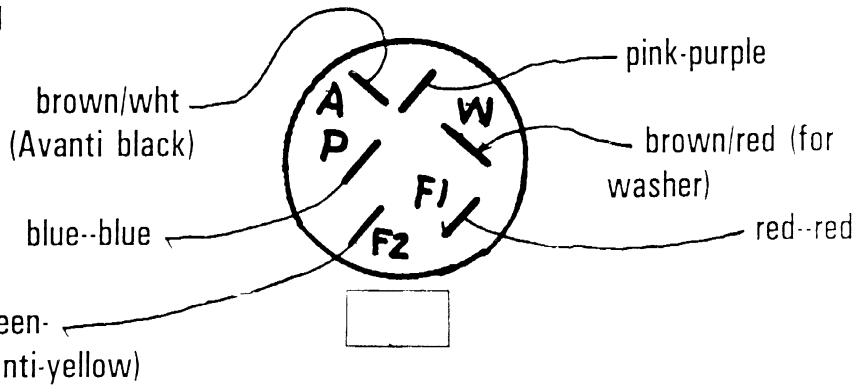

I don't know if one caused the other, but I had both a bad wiper switch and a bad wiper motor. Both are, as far as I know, unavailable. I secured a motor by advertising and paying big bucks for a used one. By looking at old cars in a junkyard, I found a switch from a 1970s Dodge Dart that was similar to the one for my Avanti. To make the adaptation:

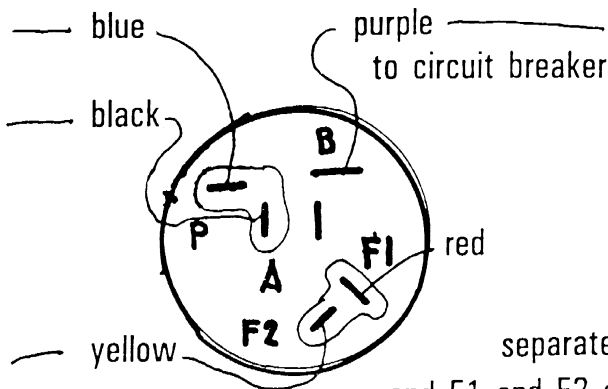


be careful that wires don't short on the steering column support!

- optional connections:
1. use Dodge plug and splice wires
 2. put new spades on Avanti wires

separate wires P-A and F1 and F2 so they will fit on Dodge switch

*option- leave the shaft a little long and use the washer activation
